Dear Mr Williams

Proposed extraction of limestone and clay as extension to Southam Quarry, screening and storage of material for offsite transportation to Rugby Cement Works, creation of new haulage route from extension area to processing area, and associated landscaping, screening and restoration works at land at Spiers Farm, Southam Cement Works, Southam Road, Long Itchington

I write in response to your consultation dated 11th August 2010 regarding the above planning application.

In accordance with my delegated powers, I write to confirm that following the East Area Planning Committee on 17th November 2010 at which the application was heard, the committee resolved to raise **objection** to this proposal for the reasons set out below:

1. The proposals would have an adverse impact on the amenity of local residents, particularly as a result of the generation of noise and dust, contrary to Policies DEV.1 and PR.8 of the Stratford on Avon District Local Plan Review 1996-2011.
2. The proposals would have an adverse visual impact in the surrounding area, particularly as a result of the formation of bunds around the site, contrary to Policies PR.1 and CTY.1 of the Stratford on Avon District Local Plan Review 1996-2011
