

Household Waste Recycling Centres (HWRC's)

The Sites are provided to help you:

- Re use: items which are in good condition and safe to re use.
- Recycle: items such as paper and glass.
- Dispose: of non recyclable household waste.

What to expect when you visit

The Sites have different containers for different materials. Please put your items into the correct containers. The signage at the Site should help you.

Sites can get busy, to make your visit quicker and easier we suggest sorting your items at home before your visit.

Height restriction barriers (6'6"/1.9m) are in use at Grendon, Burton Farm, Cherry Orchard and Shipston.

In order to maximise recycling, black bags may be opened by Site staff.

For your own safety please adhere to safety guidance given by signs and Site Staff.

If you require any assistance during your visit please do not hesitate to ask.



Can I use a Van or Pick-up Truck?

Household waste delivered in vans and pick-ups is not accepted. If your households only vehicle is a small van or pick up you may be able to apply for a permit to allow you to use the Sites. Vans and pick-ups are also accepted at Princes Drive or Hunters Lane on a chargeable basis. Please contact us for details.

Can I use trailer?

Cars towing small trailers with household waste from your own home are accepted and do not need a permit. Large trailers (over 6ft) are only accepted on a chargeable basis at Princes Drive and Hunters Lane.

What if I have something that is not listed?

You may be asked to follow special disposal procedures for some items such as garden chemicals, paint, medicines or gas cylinders, as they can be hazardous to the environment if not disposed of correctly. Before delivering unusual items please check if they are accepted at the Site.

Do you collect bulky items?

There are a number of re use charities that may be able to accept your item please contact us for details. Alternatively your local Council can provide a bulky waste collection. Please contact them directly for charges and to book a collection.

Your questions answered

Can I bring soil, rubble or DIY waste to the Sites?

Soil, rubble and items from the fabric of a building are not classed as household waste and as such are not covered within our statutory provision.

We recognise many people carry out occasional projects and therefore, we accept small amounts with a maximum limit of 3 x 25kg bags a month.

Can I take anything away from the Sites?

You are not permitted to remove items from the Sites for any purpose, once they have been deposited into a container, unless purchasing an item from the re-use shop.

Summer times

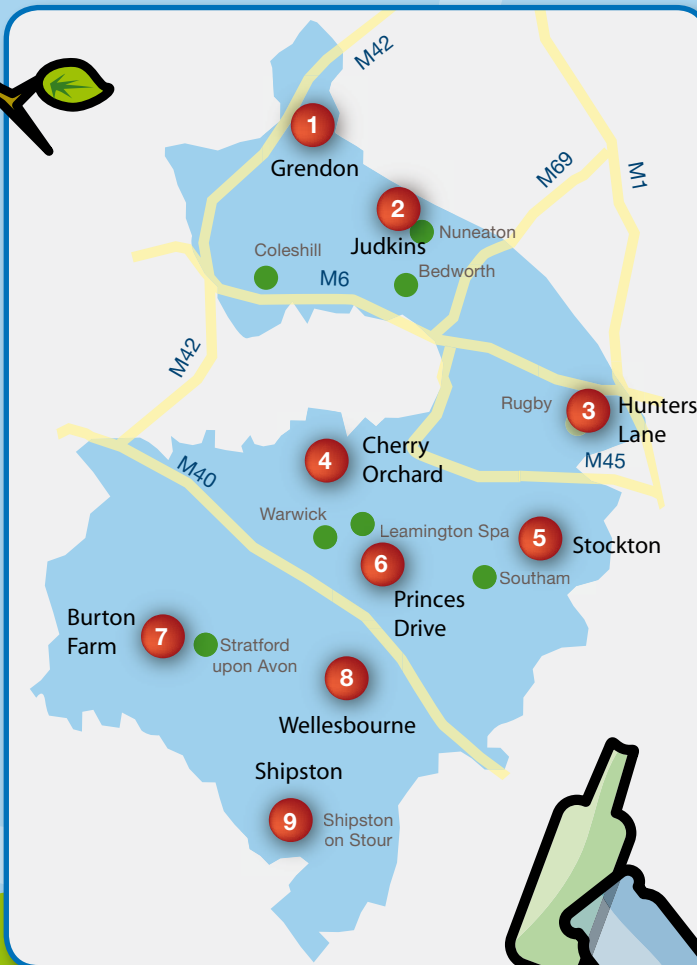
Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, Friday - 9:30 to 15:15*
