Cllr.Crump noted that he has applied for funding from HS2 to spend in his ward. It was noted that the Mid shires junction is dangerous and Cllr.Crump has asked for better signage, but this is not really in his ward.

Cllr.Crump noted that some County Council grant money is still available.

It was noted that further HS2 roadworks will be managed by traffic lights rather than closure.

Cllr.Crump is still trying to get some further work done at the Stockton crossroads on A426 especially from the L.Itchington side of the junction, and noted that the Parish council still must remind the highways department when the grass at the crossroads is long
