Items 16.& 17 District and County Council Issues

Cllr.Crump noted that a job repair has been raised to repair the pothole at the junction High Street/Napton Road.

Cllr Crump will have the water pooling in Elm Row inspected.

Cllr.Crump will look into the pothole in George Street

Cllr,Crump noted that the grass verge opposite the Crown Inn is highways land, and the offer of planters by the Crown Inn owners free of charge to avoid vehicles intruding on the grass verges has been made. The conditions laid down for these planters by the highways department would render the planters ineffective. Cllr.Crump noted that the County Council elections will now take place in May 2025.

Cllr.Crump also asked residents to come to the SWLP event at Southam Library on the 18th February from 10.00am until 4.00pm to look at the potential development areas around Stockton, Southam, and Napton that may be developed to meet government requirements.

SDC prefers a 2 unitary model for Warwickshire (North and South) but this is not supported by WDC or RBC. The unitary is likely to happen in April 2028, but there has been little or no consultation by government whose preferred size of unitary authority is 500K plus.
