Village needs investment to sustain current population:

Roads too narrow and dangerous for children Utilities, particularly water and sewerage The shop does not meet needs Speeding through village a big issue Potholes a danger Parking a major problem Pavements uneven

No more development

Historically, developers have agreed to provide community benefits but do not deliver

If there is new development the infrastructure of Stockton needs to be significantly improved, particularly water/sewerage
School full - influx of new children will cause problems
Cannot support more traffic safely
Significant increase in population will put pressure on doctors, pharmacists, etc
Already sufficient housing stock - shared ownership homes available

Improvement suggestions

Attract local businesses - hairdressers, butchers, better shop

Provision of more parking areas

Larger school and better play areas for children

Revised bus service, including evenings, with a better turn round for buses
Introduce speed restrictions

Need affordable housing to allow grand children to stay in village and those with local connections to move here

Better street lighting

Dog exercise fields

Objections to Richborough proposals

A426 access too dangerous and access via Sycamore Close will put extra pressure on the village's already crowded roads with 160+ extra cars Newcomers bringing anti-social behaviour

Most people who move into vacant houses do not have local connections
